Biodiesel dramatically reduces harmful emissions that cause environmental problems such as global warming, acid rain and smog.

Health problems that are caused by emissions exposure can be greatly reduced by the cleaner emissions of biodiesel.

Biodiesel is a renewable fuel source, unlike fossil fuels.

Bioheat Bill

The NYC Bioheat Bill proposes groundbreaking legislation that will ban some of the most polluting heating oil blends and replace them with cleaner, biodiesel blended heating oil. This legislation will greatly reduce emissions that harm our health and reduce the city's carbon footprint by an estimated 337 million pounds – the equivalent of removing approximately 30,000 cars from the road each year!

We have been working on this bill for years and believe it's almost through the finish line with support of environmental groups, labor representatives, industry organizations and the mayor's office of sustainability. Please help get this great legislation across the finish line by calling Mayor Bloomberg's office and your local City Council representative and ask them to support swift passage of the bioheat bill.
